Each genre has subcategories.



Fiction

- Fake, Not true, make-believe
- Beginning, middle, end
- Animated pictures or artwork
- Sometimes can not really happen
- Character, plot, and setting

Non-Fiction

- real. true
- Facts
- Bold print
- Real photographs
- Diagrams
- Really can happen

Fiction vs Nonfiction

Fiction: Going Deeper

- Historical Fiction: set in the past and based on real people and/or events
- Science Fiction: has aliens, robots, futuristic technology and/or space ships
- Realistic Fiction: has no elements of fantasy; could be true but isn't
- Fantasy: has monsters, magic, or characters with superpowers
- Mystery: Detectives try to find clues to solve an unknown.



Nonfiction: Going Deeper

- Informational: books on specific topics that provide information and facts.
- Reference: books like a dictionary, thesaurus, atlas, or almanacs.
- Persuasive: writing for the purto people to do something; advertising, editorials,
- Autobiography.: a story written by a person about their life.
- Biography: a story about someone written by someone else.
